1 Introduction

Title 49 of the U.S. *Code of Federal Regulations* (49 CFR), relating to cylinder markings, was changed effective January 1, 1983, and owner symbols were no longer required on cylinders [1].¹ Similarly, Canada's, *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations* do not require ownership symbols to be stamped on cylinders [2]. The Compressed Gas Association (CGA) and the compressed gas industry recognize the value of owner symbols on cylinders and believe these valuable markings should be maintained. CGA serves as the registrar for permanent owner symbols.

2 Scope

This publication lists the CGA-registered symbols and companies owning them. See Tables 1, 2, and 3. Since this will be updated regularly, it will be published more often than CGA C-16, *CGA Cylinder Registration Program for Cylinder Owner Symbols* [3].
